CBD Scenario description	<p>Discuss the approach to vestibular rehabilitation that you may use for a 50-year-old woman presenting with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attack of sudden severe rotational vertigo 6 months ago • Right lateral canal low gain with overt catch-up saccades on vHIT • Imbalance with severe anxiety and avoidance in busy visual environments (e.g., supermarket) • No central signs in history, bedside or VNG testing

What should the assessor expect to see? Assessors will be asked to plan questions in advance including links</small>	<p>Considers some or all of the following points:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Underlying issue is most likely peripheral vestibular (need to consider in context of any other results) • Probable longstanding incomplete compensation • Additional psychological and psychosocial impacts • Assess for any contraindications to VR • Assesses currently triggering movements. • Graded VOR exercises • General advice re avoidance • Plan for review • Consider onward referral for psychology assessment if anxiety severe? And/or signposting to self-help tools for anxiety if less severe.
